Restoration

The majority of our restoration sites are large scale coastal plain wetlands, streams and forests that have been degraded by poor land use practices during the colonial and modern eras. Some of these projects include important infrastructure resiliency components such as sewer upgrades and protection and dam and flood safety.

Long-Term Stewardship

GTA is able to accept donations of land and conservation easements that support our mission, particularly where additional habitat restoration opportunities might be available on the property. We work with landowners to calculate proper endowment amounts and terms based on the likelihood of the property to support GTA's other conservation goals.

Mitigation Banking

Mitigation banks in Maryland require a sponsor and an operator. For government clients, GTA has successfully served as a nonprofit mitigation bank sponsor. We are always looking for banks and for bank sites that connect existing conserved lands as part of a larger, restored and more resilient landscape.

Non-Profit Fiscal Sponsor

GTA's staff have over 30 years combined experience in writing grants and proposals and serving as a nonprofit fiscal sponsor for restoration and land protection funding opportunities. We enjoy relationships with foundations, state and local government grant-makers, and complex federal grant processes including audit-ready fiscal management of large federal grant awards and contracts.



Who Is GreenTrust Alliance?

We are a nonprofit land trust whose mission is to identify degraded lands, restore them, and permanently protect them. We believe that for 21st century conservation and resiliency efforts to have meaningful impacts in the Mid-Atlantic region, they must be significantly accelerated and done at very large scales. Most of our conservation and resiliency work is done between New Jersey and North Carolina.

What We Do

We work with non-profit, government agency, and for-profit strategic partners to identify high priority lands, wetlands, and waters for restoration funding and permanent protection via tools such as conservation easements. We serve as a Long Term Steward of conservation easements including those for stream, wetland, forest, and carbon banking. In some cases we serve as a sponsor of government agency-funded mitigation banks, and on some large, complex projects we serve as technical advisors to other partners during funding, design, permitting, and construction phases of large scale restoration projects.
